Aim:

To support the academic progress of students in art. Work completed at home (or after school using school facilities outside lessons) is to support the class work / project work in the subject. Students are permitted to utilise school IT equipment before school if they wish or during lunchtime with prior arrangement.

Students work on several projects during years 7, 8 and 9 receiving homework from each different project.

Types of regular homework:
