Marking and feedback:

- 1. Hegarty maths tasks are automatically marked online giving students instant feedback when they complete the task. Students can leave comments or questions regarding a particular question which will be flagged up when the member of staff next logs on. Staff will respond to these questions to assist a student with a potential misconception.
- 2. All practice paper questions will be marked, scored and graded. Students will then improve these in green pen the following lesson as part of the CPR review process.
- 3. Revision homework will not be marked, but the expectation is that students create their own revision resources as evidence of this.
