Date	Day	Event	Additional Information
8 th February 2019	Friday	Prom launch assembly	The criteria for the prom invites will be shared with students. All students will then be RAG coded. All students then have the opportunity to improve and receive their invite.
14 th February 2019	Thursday	Intervention Parents' Evening	This is key to ensuring both students and parents know what needs to take place to help each student be ready for the final GCSE preparation phase.

25 th Feb. – 1 st March 2019	All week in lessons	GCSE Business Studies Paper 2 Mock Exam	This is essential for students to have the opportunity to attempt a Paper 2 as the examination in November only covered Paper 1.
5 th March 2019	Tuesday	GCSE PE practical moderation	This is an essential part of the GCSE course: students will know well in advance which practical(s) they will be observed in: attendance on this day is essential!
5 th March 2019	Tuesday	Drama preview evening commencing at 3.00pm	All GCSE students will have a rehearsal opportunity prior to their practical examination later this week – attendance at this event is essential.
6 th March 2019	Wednesday	Year 11 Study skills session (postponed from the snow closure day)	This is a session aimed at both parents and students about how to revise. This event is limited in the number of places and is therefore invitation only. If you particularly think this will be of benefit and you have not received an invite please contact Mr Wraith.
7 th and 8 th March 2019	Thursday - Friday	GCSE Drama practical examination	This is an essential part of the GCSE course: students will know well in advance which day they are taking their examination and attendance is essential!

11-19 th March 2019	Scheduled days	Final mock examinations – English, Maths and MFL only	Students will have a full and final mock experience for the core subjects and MFL. This will be the last opportunity before the real examinations commence.
12 th March 2019	Tuesday	AQA PE Conference	This is a superb opportunity for students to prepare for their GCSE theory examination.
22 nd March 2019	Friday	Deadline for the completion of the syllabus in all GCSE curriculum areas.	Staff will ensure that all theory/content has been covered by this deadline, so that they can help support students with their revision and final preparations for their GCSE examinations.
5 th April	Friday	Year 11 Celebration Breakfast	This assembly will be an opportunity to celebrate the year. Leavers' jumpers and yearbooks will be distributed at this event.
8 th – 22 nd April 2019	Easter break	Easter intervention sessions. Timetable coming soon.	
23 rd & 24 th April 2019.	Tuesday - Wednesday	GCSE Graphic Communication Textile Design & Fine Art examination	These are the formal GCSE Art examinations and attendance is vital.
7th -10th May 2019	Tuesday - Friday	GCSE MFL Oral examinations	Students will have a scheduled time for the completion of their MFL oral exam.
13th May 2019 onwards	Monday	GCSE exams commence (please see attached timetable for the full list of examinations)	Alternative study timetables commence as students prepare for each examination.
27th – 31st May 2019	Half-term break	Half-term intervention/revision sessions	A full programme of revision sessions will be available prior to the break.
