Dear Parents

In order to ensure a safe exit to school for students at the end of the day, I am altering, **from today, Thursday 10th September**, the staggered finish times we currently have in place. This is in line with our own risk assessment and of course described in the DFE guidance from August.

Therefore, with effect **from today, Thursday 10th September** the students will be dismissed every 5 mins from:

Year 7 at 2.45pm – Staff teaching Year 7 will escort them down to the front of school and supervise their exit from the site

Year 8/9 at 2.50pm – Staff teaching Year 8 and 9 will then escort them to the front of school and help supervise their exit from the site

Year 10 and 11 at 2.55pm

I have taken this decision to reduce the congestion along corridors, the main entrance, front of school as well as along Seal Road and the local community. This week in particular has seen a dramatic increase in traffic outside of school.

I apologise for any inconvenience this causes.
