## Bramhall High School 2021 GCSE Results

### What do our results mean?

**Basics Measure**-This year **84% of our students attained grades 9-4 in both English and mathematics and 67% achieved the very rigorous 9-5 in both English and Maths.** These are an excellent foundation for post 16 study. This is the gold standard for measuring school performance and allows our students to progress to college and beyond.

**English Baccalaureate**- This is a traditional set of qualifications that the government would like students to achieve GCSE grades in. The subjects are English, mathematics, the science subjects plus computer science, geography or history and a modern foreign language. **This year 32% of our students achieved at least grade 4 in ALL of them.**

**9-7** 42% of our students' grades were grades 9-7. We are adamant that our able students must be supported and encouraged to achieve top grades. **Bramhall High School has continued to achieve a large number of top GCSE grades in traditional academic subjects.**

**9-6** If students are looking to continue their education by taking level 3 courses like A levels it is recommended that students have at least a grade 6 in subjects that they wish to pursue including English and mathematics. **This year over 60% of all our GCSE grades were at grade 6 or above.**

**Attainment 8**- This is a new measure that looks at the subjects a student has taken and how well they have done. This figure will be used to compare how our students have done when compared to other students from a similar starting point. We achieved 57.7 which shows high attainment in all areas across the curriculum

The results of our 2021 cohort are well above national and local averages in all key areas and particular successes are evident in the new attainment measures. The results clearly show the excellent achievement made by students in all areas of our academic curriculum.

Mr Williams, Head teacher, and all the staff at Bramhall High School are obviously delighted with the results, which are a testament to the work ethic and support of students, parents and colleagues. We have maintained the excellent outcomes of previous years and are confident that these results are a significant step in our journey towards OFSTED outstanding.
