Dear Parents/Carers

Please find below the details of the timings students should come into school for their first Lateral Flow Device (LFD) Test. We can only offer the test to students where we have prior parental consent. In addition, may I highlight the following to parents/carers:-

- Students must go to Main Reception when they arrive and must be in **school uniform**.
- The tests are self-administered by students and there will be staff on hand to guide students.
- Our Asymptomatic Test site is manned by staff & volunteers who have completed the required NHS training.
- Only students will be permitted into the school and the testing site.
- Our site is located in the Gym and has six booths each separated by non-transparent screening.
- The test will be processed on site and results uploaded to the NHS test and trace site. Parents will then receive notification of the result via email or text message.
- As soon as students have completed the test, they must immediately leave the site via Main Reception. They cannot enter any other part of school.

When travelling to and from school students should do so as directly as possible. They should not gather or congregate outside of the school site or in the local community before or after their tests. Please be aware that no additional buses are being run through the day and therefore I have to ask parents/carers to organise transport for students coming in for testing. Where parents/carers are arranging to drop off and pick-up students on their test day, please arrange a suitable place away from the school site to do so. Parking on site is very limited and we ask for your co-operation in not coming onto the school site to drop-off or pick-up your child.

In addition, if your child or anyone in your household is symptomatic on the day of the test your child should stay at home and not come into school for the LFD test and should follow the national guidance.
